2010 Rules of Golf Quiz

(Each question is worth 2-PPR points; the Bonus question is worth 5-PPR points)

1. In a bunker, a player lifts his ball under the interference Rule and a fellow-competitor alters the original lie; he must place his ball in a nearby similar lie.

2. Through the green, a ball lifted to determine if it is unfit for play may be cleaned

3. If a tree basin has an artificial wall, the wall is an obstruction unless the Committee deems it to be an integral part of the golf course.
 True

4. In stroke play, a player returns a score card with his score added, which is incorrect. The Committee calculates the score and makes the correction on the score card. Due to the error the player is disqualified.

5. A player entitled to play a provisional ball from the tee plays it into the same area as his original ball. The provisional ball is indistinguishable from his original ball and both balls are found in a water hazard; he must return to the tee and play another ball.

6. If a player drops a ball under the Rules and it strikes his glove that was used to mark the area in which the ball is to be dropped, he must re-drop the ball.

7. A player's ball lies in a tree; if he deems the ball unplayable and then dislodges it by shaking the tree, there is no penalty from moving his ball in play.

8. Which is correct regarding a player searching for a ball?

If he moves his ball while searching for it, he is not penalized.

He may not search for his lost ball after he puts another ball into play even if play is not unduly delayed.

Upon reaching the area where the original ball is lost, a player has 5-minutes to locate and play his ball.

If a fellow-competitor moves the player's ball while helping search for it, he is not penalized and the ball must be replaced in its original position.

9. Two players exchange balls in error after holing out, with each playing the other's ball from the next teeing ground; they have each played a wrong ball with penalty.
